

UPDATE: Fatal crash victim identified

Not wearing a seat-belt was a factor in the death of a 27-year-old Sarnia man whose motor vehicle rolled over into a ditch in Plympton-Wyoming, early today.

Dead is Travis Sitter, who was unbuckled and ejected from his vehicle when it rolled into the ditch, Lambton OPP said.

Around 12:10 a.m. on Aug. 4, emergency workers were called to Lakeshore Road between Fleming Road and Egremont Road in response to the crash.

OPP reports Sitter's Hyundai car was going north on Lakeshore Road when it left the road and rolled into the ditch. Sitter, the lone occupant, was pronounced dead at the scene.

Responding were OPP, Lambton County EMS and the Camlachie Volunteer Fire Department .

OPP technical traffic collision investigators and OPP forensic identification unit officers were at the scene and a post-mortem examination is expected to take place later today at Bluewater Health in Sarnia.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation and OPP would like to speak to anyone who witnessed it. If anyone has information to help investigators, they can call Lambton OPP at 1-888-310-1122 or 519-882-1011.
